To Whom it May Concern:

I am writing in support of Prince William County, Cities of Manassas and Manassas Park's for the Opioid Abatement Authority's (OAA) partnership application. The Prince William Community Services (CS) will address the opioid epidemic in the Greater Prince William community by creating an Office Based Addiction Treatment Program (OBAT). The establishment of an OBAT would provide critical support to those struggling with addiction, and help to mitigate the negative consequences of this public health epidemic.

I believe CS is an exceptional candidate for this opportunity because of their proven track record of delivering high quality, evidence-based services to individuals struggling with addiction. Their multi-disciplinary team of experienced and committed professionals are dedicated to serving the Prince William community's residents who experience an array of complex behavioral health and social needs, and are being seen in a variety of treatment settings in increasing numbers.
