The Roanoke Valley Collective Response began in 2018 as an all-volunteer collective action effort formed by key stakeholders in the Roanoke Valley – including leaders in healthcare systems, homelessness programs, harm reduction, the Virginia Department of Health, academia, and more - to address what was already a crisis of addiction in the region. That crisis has only been worsened by the ensuing COVID-19 pandemic and resultant economic and social challenges in the area. Since its formation, the Collective Response has produced the *Blueprint for Action*, a report of evidence-based strategies for addressing addiction in the Roanoke region, and *Building on Hope*, a white paper focused on the specific challenges facing addiction and recovery services as a result of the pandemic.

In 2021, the Collective Response became formalized as a staffed program under the Roanoke Valley-Alleghany Regional Commission, expanding its geographic reach and tightening its relationship with local governments. It has grown its capacity to help localities identify, prioritize, and implement abatement programs efficiently, and we believe the additional growth and stability that funding through the VOAA's Cooperative Projects program is critical in our efforts to help our own communities as well as developing and deploying an effective regional response to the crisis.

As the only collective action organization of its type in the Commonwealth, the Roanoke Valley Collective Response also positions our region in the best position to implement effective programs quickly, and to assist other regions with technical support as needed.
