Overview of Proposed Grant Program:									
This grant will be used to enhance and expand the capacity of the regional Crisis Intervention Team Assessment Center (CITAC) by expanding hours from 4pm-midnight to 24/7 operations. Rockingham is pursuing federal funding for the additional weekday coverage and these funds will be used for the weekend coverage. CITAC officers will also expand screening and tracking for substance use (including opioid use), and distribute material on treatment and harm reduction outreach efforts.

Summary of Staff Review and Recommendations									
Rockingham County is providing matching funds of \$19,632 from their direct distributions which along with Harrisonburg's \$19,632 individual distribution match comes out to a 17% match for year 1. Both subdivisions have pledged a match of \$4,274 each for each of the out years of the project.									
Project objectives include: 1) expand hours of law enforcement coverage at the CITAC to increase the capacity to provide warm hand-offs for individuals with Mental Health Disorders (MHDs) and Substance Use Mental Health Disorders (SUMHDs), 2) reduce officer wait time at the CITAC and allow them to return lo the field more quickly, 3)expand information and referrals provided to individuals and their families about community-based MH and SUD/OUD treatment services, 4) Expand harm reduction outreach, 5) increase distribution of naloxone kits and fentanyl test strips to at-risk individuals, and 6)increase data tracking for crisis response planning and evaluation.									
Rockingham and Harrisonburg also have another Cooperative Partnership application (CRU) and a Cooperative Planning grant application.									
Staff recommends full approval with the following contingencies before the OAA funds will be transmitted:  1) All cooperative partnership projects are expected to complete an operational agreement between all partners. 2) For any awards that rely on other sources of funding (e.g., other grants), the fiscal agent must demonstrate that the non-OAA funding has been secured. (this clause should not be used for funding relying on patient revenue). Additionally, the project should achieve sustainable funding without OAA assistance by FY29.
