Overview of Proposed Grant Program:
Washington County and the City of Bristol. These localities have submitted a grant application to request funds for the purchase of a building; Fairview Housing will provide a match of \$755,000 through securing a loan on the property; the remaining balance will be a request from the OAA for \$745,000. Fairview Housing, LLC will operate the facility and provide treatment and related services. Fairview Housing has been providing residential treatment for OUD/SUD for 22 years.

Summary of Staff Review and Recommendations
The above localities have entered into a cooperative partnership to apply for funding from the OAA for the purchase of a building in Abindgon, VA. The building will be used to operate a 54-bed ASAM 3.1 residential facility for women with OUD and/or SUD. There is no facility with this level of care within 150 miles of Abingdon, which creates a barrier to access to residential treatment for women. Targeted beneficiaries of this project are women 18 and older with OUD and/or SUD that are homeless, post incarceration, drug court diversion, post-detox and 28-day programs and do not require a higher level of care, such as extreme mental or physical health issues. If awarded, the localities will enter into an agreement with Fairview Housing, LLC to operate the facility and provide OUD/SUD treatment and related services. Fairview Housing currently operates a similar facility in Bristol, VA. for men age 18 and older and has a proven track record of success; facility has been able to remain sustainable through billable services. This proposed facility will fall under the same license as the Bristol facility, and is currently licensed by the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services (DBHDS). For FY24, this proposed facility will serve approximately 180 to 195 women. The purchase of the facility will reduce Mended Women's monthly operating costs thereby improving long-term sustainability of the project.
Staff recommends full approval with unrestricted funds with the following contingencies before the OAA funds will be transmitted:  1) All cooperative partnership projects are expected to complete an operational agreement between all partners.  2) For any awards involving capital costs for real property, an agreement will be executed between the fiscal agent and sub-recipient/vendor that ensures the facility will remain in operation for at least 15 years or funding will be returned to the OAA with the option at the OAA's discretion that it will accept payment at a rate of depreciation based on the subsequent years the facility was expected to operate.  3) For any awards that rely on other sources of funding (e.g., other grants, loans), the fiscal agent must demonstrate that the
