Total Amount Requested from the OAA for FY24: Indiv. Planning - \$442,755 Overview of Proposed Grant Program:
Chesterfield County has identified the need for a 24-hour behavioral health facility with services such as
crisis drop-off/respite, 23-hour holds, as well as short-term withdrawal management ("detox") and substance use treatment initiation. The County is seeking a planning grant to identify various models and options for creating a center to accomplish these goals.

Summary of Staff Review and Recommendations
Chesterfield seeks to hire a contractor to facilitate a planning effort that would identify specific needs and potential models for the facility. The contractor and existing Chesterfield staff would travel to five facilities in similar communities for research. The initial proposal seeks a total of \$491,950 with a 10% match (\$49,195) from Chesterfield's direct distribution, resulting in an OAA request of \$442,755. Chesterfield's original application sough \$400,000 for research and design services from an architectural firm. Subsequently Chesterfield agreed to remove this component from the scope of the project and make it part of the future implementation efforts (rather than part of the planning).
If awarded, this grant would require Chesterfield to create a plan that would provide options for opening a behavioral health care center that would provide services to people with opioid use disorders and co-occurring substance use disorders or mental health conditions. Chesterfield has committed that such a facility would be funded through a variety of sources without the expectation for the OAA to fund all the costs of construction or operation in the future.
Chesterfield's revised proposal totals \$91,950 with a 10% match (\$9,195) from its direct distributions. Staff recommends OAA award of \$82,755.
