Overview of Proposed Grant Program:
Henrico County is seeking to expand its Medication for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD) services in its jail population. The grant will add additional hours for a medical doctor or prescriber in the jail to serve the OUD population.

Summary of Staff Review and Recommendations
This grant would expand an existing medical treatment program that serves people in the jail with opioid use disorders. Henrico expects to increase the number of people served from 60 per year to 94 (roughly a 57% increase).
Henrico's existing jail treatment program is largely funded with a State Opioid Response (SOR) grant administered by the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services (DBHDS). Henrico is concerned about the sustainability of federal funding for SOR funds, and for that reason its original application sought \$576,177 from the OAA to simultaneously replace the SOR funds and expand the MOUD program. Henrico would have then sought permission from DBHDS to divert its SOR funds to other opioid-related projects in Henrico County. After discussion with OAA staff, Henrico revised its application to seek only the expansion cost of \$70,200. Should SOR funds not be awarded in the future, the County will consider other funding sources as well as future OAA grants to maintain the MOUD program in the jail.
Staff recommends fully funding the requested grant in the amount of \$70,200.
