Summary of Staff Review and Recommendations	
Salem City has submitted a multi-project planning grant application. Salem City has submitted a multi-project planning grant application. The proposal seeks to create a diverse work group that would consist of city employees from a variety of departments; to provide training opportunities to this group to learn about best practices and abatement strategies; to create surveys to collect information and conduct research to analyze results; and to hire a consultant to conduct a needs assessment that results in a plan for use of available Opioid Abatement Funds. The proposed cost total is \$228,355 with Salem City providing a match of \$22,835.50 from their Direct Distribution funding, resulting in an OAA request of \$205,519.50.

After review of the application, staff reached out to Salem for some modifications to the application based on a previously awarded OAA planning grant of similar population size, scope of services, and funding required for the planning effort. The OAA staff proposed a total project cost of \$50,000 with a 10% match from the City of \$5,000, which would result in an OAA request of \$45,000. The city responded and accepted the proposed modification to their application.

Staff recommend the modified proposal offer of an OAA award of \$45,000 with a contingency that any RFPs issued will include cooperative procurement language.
