- Mission provide housing or housing related services for gaps in the continuum of care. Primarily includes Opioid and SUD prevention and treatment.
- 40 community partners (social capital) helping to provide all needs and services for clients.

• Service area is 13 counties in SW Virginia and 11 counties in NE Tennessee

- 300 recovery beds 150 in VA, 150 in TN
- In 2022, in addition to Fairview's recovery beds, we assisted 651 individuals and families from homelessness, or from becoming homeless.
