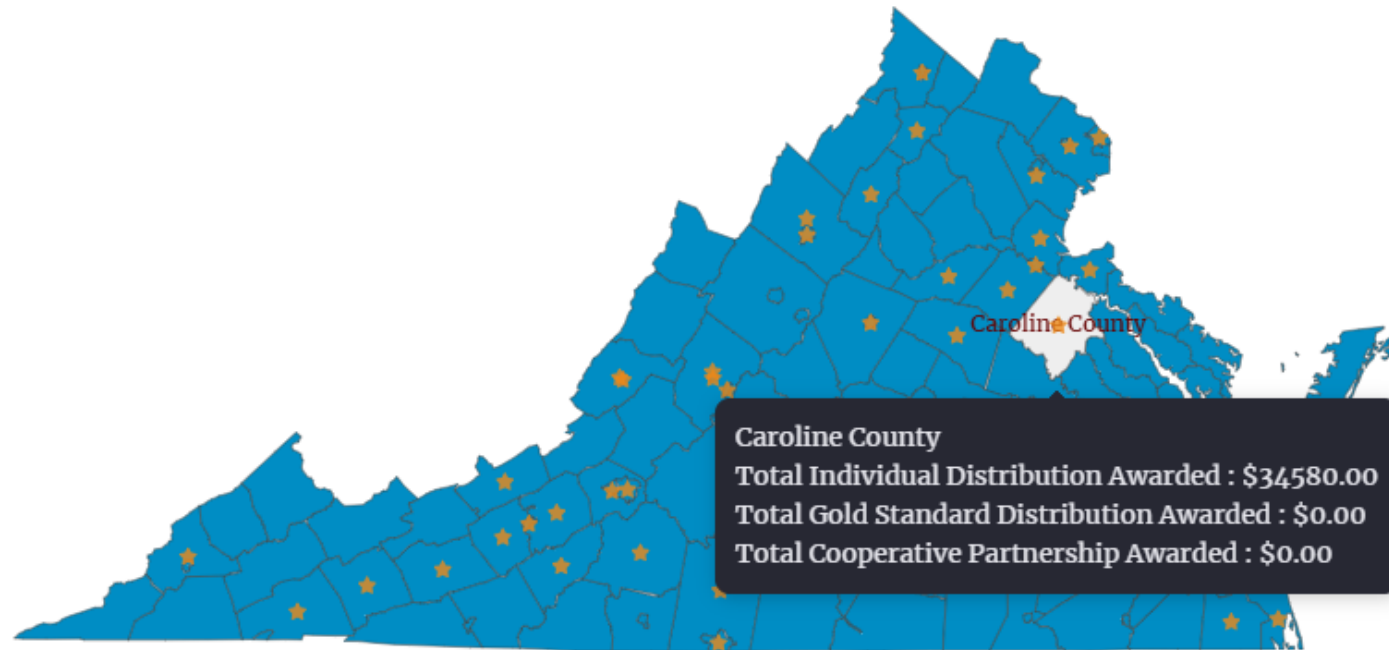

Virginia Commonwealth Opioid Abatement and Remediation Fund Overview

The Commonwealth Opioid Abatement and Remediation (COAR) Fund (§ 2.2-2377, Code of Virginia) is a non-reverting fund established to receive the commonwealth's share of opioid settlement funds. The General Assembly appropriates COAR funds in the Virginia budget through the legislative process. COAR funds are to be used exclusively for opioid abatement and remediation purposes, pursuant to statute.
