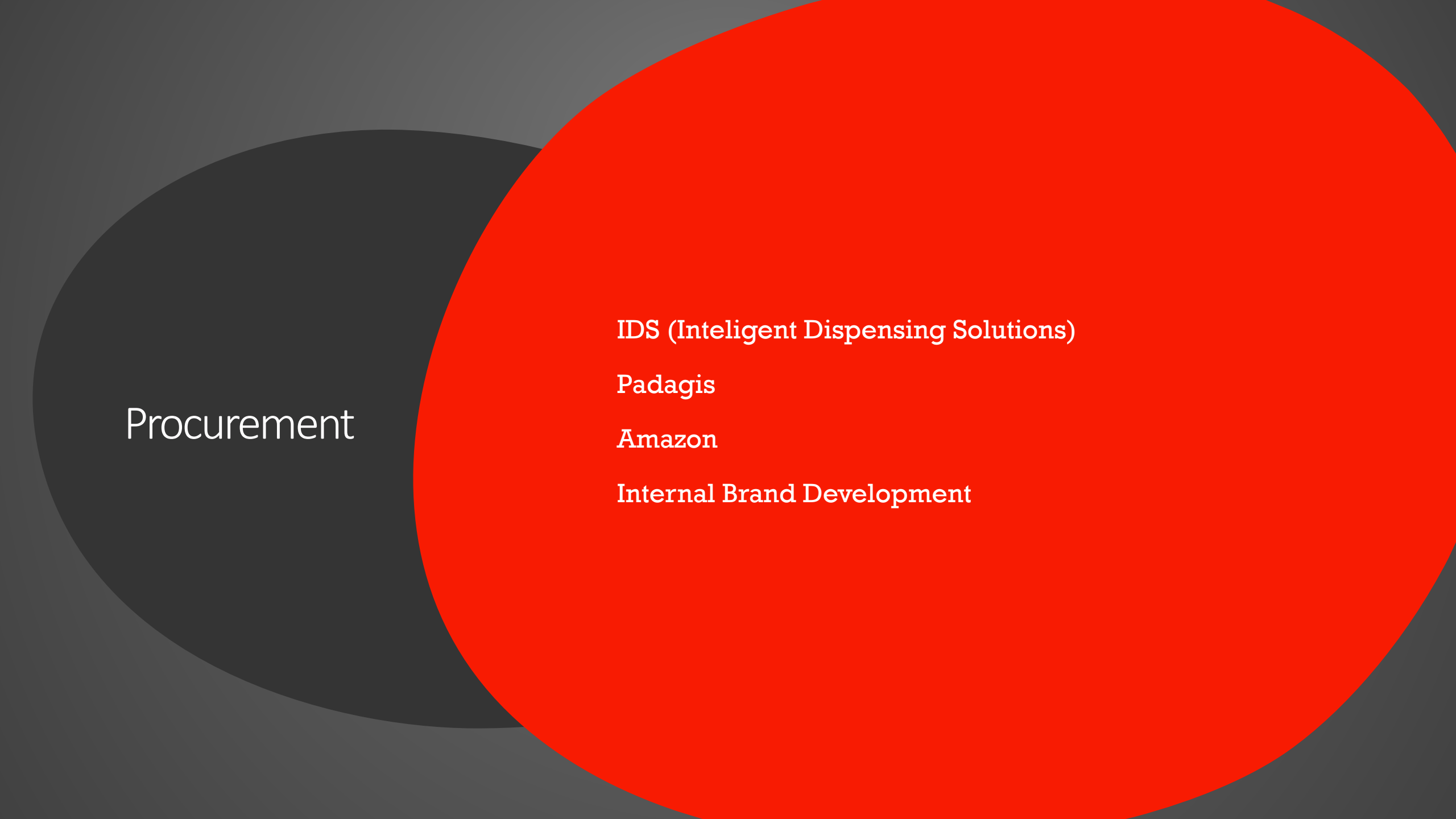

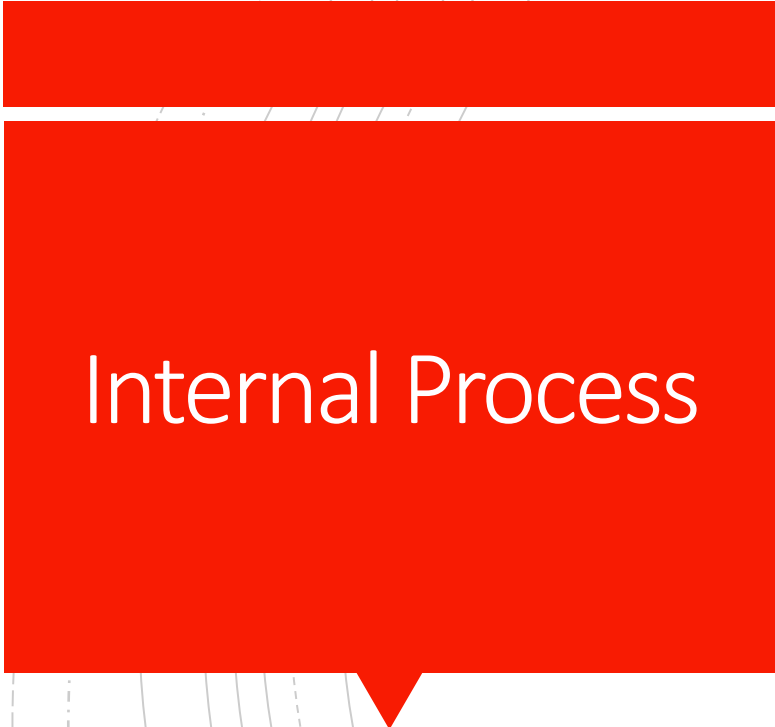

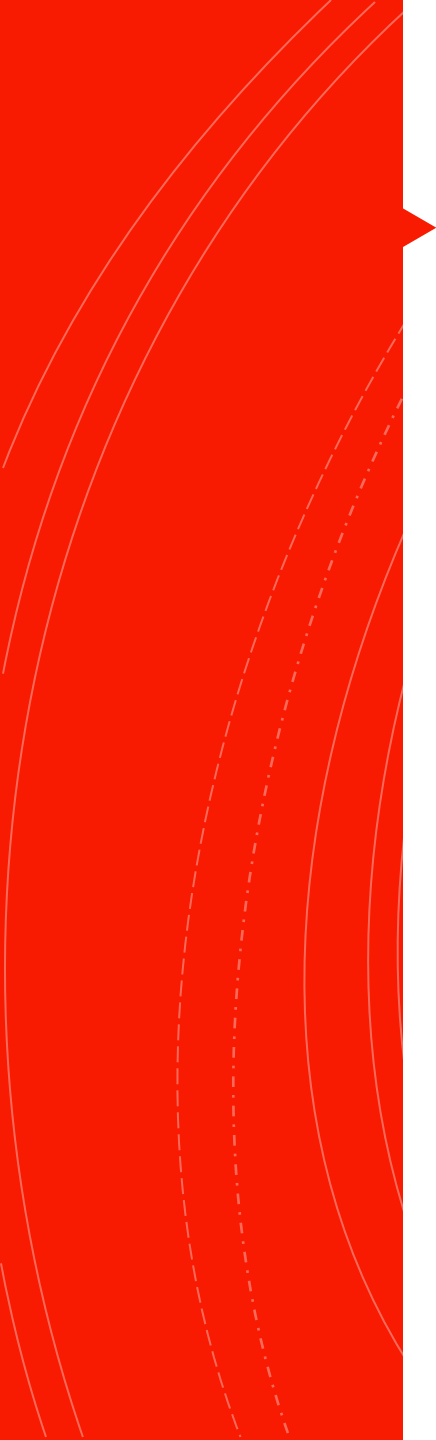
Application Process

Narrative	HRVMs in high traffic, high overdose areas have been shown to reduce fatal overdoses
Ask	Funding to purchase the machines, software agreements, inventory, re-stocking staff
Items	Naloxone, test strips, wipes, menstrual products, first aid, toothbrush/toothpaste

Internal Process

- 01** Identify project and apply to OAA
- 02** Create budget, find locations, site prep
- 03** Receive funding from OAA
- 04** Present to Mayor and City Counsel
- 05** Order inventory and deploy machines
